Lt Charles Smith, County of Los Angeles Sheriff's Department informed the Governance Board that the JPA is scheduled to go before the LA RICS Committee next week, then Los Angeles City Council for a vote. The LA RICS JPA Committee meets twice weekly. It is scheduled to go out to bid before the end of October.
